

Rye Brook Bar Mitzvah boy collects for community garden

For his Hased Bar Mitzvah project at Congregation KTI in Port Chester, Greyson Oling of Rye Brook collected tools and other items for the new Weber Community Garden in Port Chester. While donations are still being accepted, Greyson handed most of the goods over to Alex Payan, director of Port Chester Cares who coordinated the garden's creation, on Friday, Apr. 29. That included monies collected (just over \$150 thus far).

"The hope is that the community at large sees the value of the community garden to build lifelong skills, create fresh food, and bring people together," said Greyson's mother Rebecca. "Alex said he already sees the community beginning to watch out for it and protect it from vandals."
